Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect and use the information you provide through this website.

What Information Do We Collect?

When you visit the Fraser Coast Jobs Website you may provide us with two types of information: personal information you knowingly choose to disclose such as your contact details and your employment requirements or skills and experiences; and website use information that is collected as you browse this website, such as date and time of visit, the pages viewed, time spent on pages and the web sites visited just before and just after this web site. This information is collected using "Cookies" (see below) and Web Server Logs.

How We Use Your Information?

Your personal information is used to administer the services of this website, provide customer service to you and to provide data for analysis of employment opportunities and issues. Occasionally, we may also use the information we collect to notify you about important changes to this website, new services and special offers that may be of value to you. You can notify the webmaster at any time if you do not wish to receive these offers by clicking on the "Contact Us" button on the home page.

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a website, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a website to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites.

How We Use the Information We Collect from Cookies?

As you browse this website, the site uses its cookies to differentiate you from other users so your information is only available to you. In some cases, we also use cookies to prevent you from seeing unnecessary advertisements or requiring you to log in more than is necessary for security. Cookies, in conjunction with our web server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our website and which parts of the site are most popular. This helps us gather feedback in order to constantly improve our website and better serve our customers. Cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not generally store any personal information that you provided to us in your cookies.

Third Parties

We will not disclose your personal information to any other person or organisation unless: you have given us your consent to do so; the information is needed to conduct a transaction between you and a third party; we are required by law to do so; there are grounds to believe disclosure will prevent a threat to life or health; or the third party is providing a service to the Webmaster and is required to maintain the same or similar privacy legislation principles.

Security of Your Information

Email is not recognised as a secure medium of communication. For this reason, we request that you do not send private information to us by email. Some of the information you may enter on our website may be transmitted securely via Secure Sockets Layer (SSL), 128 bit encryption services, which are enabled by VeriSign, Inc. Pages utilising this technology will have URLs that start with HTTPS instead of HTTP. Please "Contact Us" if you have any questions or concerns.

How to Access Your Information

You may request access to all you personally identifiable information that we collect online and maintain in our database by logging into the website and updating your user profile. You can access other information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
